Dr. Garg and his Implant Dentistry Continuum Education program have provided this training to thousands of dentist for over two decades. The IDIA's Miami Series graduation – celebrated January 18-19, 2014 – is a triumph that encourages alumni and other interested clinicians to further their education in implant dentistry, while recognizing the achievements of the current class.
